Growers travel 250km to GrainFlow

Growers are carting wheat as far as 250 kilometres to GrainFlow's Jondaryan receival site as this year's harvest approaches peak activity.

Site supervisor John Geary said the site was achieving an excellent turnaround rate and its current hours of 7.30am to 4.00pm would likely be extended to cope with demand.

"I expect the harvest to pick up in about 10 days and we'll operate accordingly," Mr Geary said.

"In the meantime, nearly everything we have tested so far has been very good quality."

He said growers who use GrainFlow warehousing get the month of delivery and two extra months for free. Fees are then \$1.45 per tonne per month until October 2010 when fees would be reviewed.

Jondaryan is one of 22 Australian GrainFlow network sites in Qld, NSW, Victoria and South Australia.

"The company has made a \$9.5 million investment in new loaders, analysis equipment and procedures to continually improve our overall performance," Mr Geary said.
