### Grain growers should monitor prices

Grain growers should monitor prices at least twice a day if they are to maximise their returns, Bellata GrainFlow site supervisor David Hutcheon has advised as the winter harvest enters its second week.

Mr Hutcheon said prices were most often revised mid morning and growers should monitor prices after that time.

The Bellata site is currently operating from 8 am to 6 pm with a likely extension to these hours as the harvest reaches its peak.

“Growers and transport operators should leave their mobile numbers with us at the site so that we can send them updated operating hours by SMS,” Mr Hutcheon said.

Bellata receivals were steady with APH 1 and 2; H2; Chickpeas; APW and DR1 and 2 being the most prominent grades. “There’s also a bit of AUH2 around,” Mr Hutcheon said.

He said there would be an early close to F1 barley and growers of this grain should contact the site directly to finalise their deliveries.

“The early F1 closure will allow us to operate a Durum segregation,” Mr Hutcheon said.

The Bellata site is part of the Australian GrainFlow network operating 22 receival sites across Queensland, NSW, Victoria and South Australia.
