Communicate key points for the management of overloaded vehicles for the 1617 harvest and the variances between the different states. This is a fact sheet only and the reference documents must be referred to for the detailed information.

It is our intention to have policies and procedures in place to deter transport operators from overloading heavy vehicles.

QLD – We will operate under the AgForce Queensland harvest management Scheme

- **GML** < 7.5 % there will be legal tolerances over their GML for all trucks eligible and operating under the scheme. Vehicles > 7.5% to <15% over the GML will be issued with notices and reported as normal to the governing body. Vehicles > 15% will be issued with 3 strikes and banned for the balance of harvest. Vehicles greater than 20% will be issued 1 strike and banned for the balance of harvest
- **CML** – Not applicable to QLD
- **HML** – Not applicable for QLD given road access
