

GROWER OUTTURN WAREHOUSED GRAIN VIC, NSW & QLD - SEASON 2023/2024

In accordance to the GrainFlow Warehousing Terms & Conditions, specifically:

- a) The grain must be picked up from the site of delivery.
- b) The grain can only be picked up when coinciding with the outturning of that grade of grain from the site
- c) The grower will be responsible for organising all transport associated with grain outturn
- d) Any amounts less than 200 tonne must be taken in a single lot (same day)
- e) Any amounts larger than 200 tonne must be outturned at a minimum of 200 tonne lots (until the last lot)
- f) A shrinkage factor will apply (as per below)
- g) The outturned grain will be of the quality of the stack average
- h) The grower must pay any outstanding warehouse fees prior to the outturning of any stock
- i) For amounts less than 300mt, the grower will be invoiced at month end following the outturn
- j) For amounts larger than 300mt, the grower will be invoiced for the following charges which must be paid prior to the outturning of any stock
- k) If the outturn occurs before the billing day of the month of outturn, a monthly warehouse fee will still be incurred.
